What is **Philanthropic Psychology?**

- Philanthropy (Greek Root: Phil-anthropy)
 - Love of humankind
- Psychology (Greek Root: Psyche logos)
 - Study/research of psyche/soul (e.g. our sense of who we are or its expression)
- OPhilanthropic psychology:
 - The study of how people love humankind/people
 - o This includes how we love ourselves and how we love others
 - o This requires us to know who is doing the loving and who is loved
 - o This requires us to know what love means
